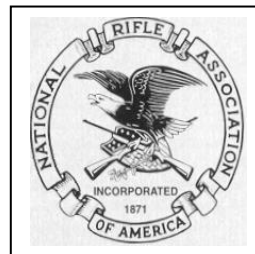

RANGE LOCATION: On US-70, 3½ miles east of US-285; turn south through yellow gate.

Most matches are held year-around [*National Match Course Competitions and Junior Program excepted*]. No regularly scheduled match will be cancelled short of disaster. If in doubt, call Match Director.

Shooters with firearms/loads damaging targets are subject to disqualification by Match Directors.

WEDNESDAY before 1ST SATURDAY:

Retiree or 'O-F' Low Power Silhouette: Range #6; same match as listed for 1st Saturday. Match Director; Scotty Davis 622-2498. 'Match Winner', 'Class Winner', and 'In-a-Row' pins available. (*)

1ST FRIDAY:

'O-F' .22 Benchrest Match: Sight-In Range. Match Director Jim Pruett, 622-0222. Spring/Summer Practice starts by 7:30am, match starts at 9:00am. Three classes: Sporting, up to 7½ pounds with scope no more than 6 power; 10.5 lbs. Class with scope of any power; Unlimited Weight Class with open scope power; and an Open Sights, any rifle class. Targets cost \$0.50. Bring target stand.

1ST SATURDAY:

Low Power Silhouette: Range #6. Match Director Scotty Davis, 622-2498. Practice 7:30am, match starts 9:00am. 40 rounds offhand, current NRA Pistol Silhouette Rules apply with exception of equipment, and ammunition, which requires a rifle with any sight, loaded single shot. With the exception of .22 Hornet, all cartridges must have case length 1.4" or less. .222 Rem. and .223 Rem. are 'OK' as long as fired with LEAD (CAST) BULLET ONLY. Shooters will be required to set their own targets. Course of fire: 10 chickens @ 40m; 10 pigs @ 50m; 10 turkeys @ 75m; and 10 rams @ 100m. Classifications: First time shooters, Unclassified, "B" Class = 0-14 scored hits, "A" Class = 15-20, "AA" Class = 21-27, "AAA" Class = 28-33, and Master Class = 34-40. Awards will be given for overall high scorer, and for first place in each class. Match fee \$6.00; free to first time shooters. Cartridges and loads will be determined suitable by the Match Director.

1ST SUNDAY:

.22 Hunter Pistol, Center Fire Hunter Pistol, .22 Cowboy Rifle Silhouette, and Cowboy Low Power Silhouette: Range #6. Match Director, James Cravener, 622-4097. Practice @ 7:30am. . Center-fire Hunter Pistol and 22 Hunter Pistol Match begins at 9:00 A.M. .22 Cowboy Silhouette held in conjunction with .22 Hunter Pistol Matches, Cowboy "Low Power" match held in conjunction with Big Bore Hunter Pistol. Course of fire: Same as Low Power Silhouette above. Equipment for Hunter Pistol: No sight restrictions, 10 ¾" maximum barrel lengths. Match fee \$6.00.

Cowboy Silhouette: *Cowboy .22 Silhouette* Equipment: Tube fed lever or pump action rifles, or era type single shots, firing .22 Rimfire ammunition only (*No magnums!*), no bolt action or semi automatic rifles. *Cowboy 'Low-Power':* Limited to Cowboy type firearms (lever action, etc.) firing pistol cartridge length ammo. Junior shooters may shoot non-standard rifles with the approval of the Match Director. Awards presented as in "Low Power" Match listed above. Fees: \$6.00 Adult, \$3.00 Junior. No charge to first time participants.

WEDNESDAY before 2nd SATURDAY:

'O-F' Any .22 Long Rifle Cartridge Match: Range #6 (*occasionally Range #3*) Match Director Jim Pruett 622-0222 (Same as the Dennis Sullivan 22LR Cartridge (100m) Silhouette Match, on 4th Saturday). Overall Winner, Class Winner, and In-A-Row Pins available (*)

(Note: This particular Wednesday match may vary monthly depending upon where the 2nd Saturday falls, check with Match Director before making plans)

2nd SATURDAY:

Bench Rest "Chicken" Silhouette Match: Range #5. Match Director Bill Kennedy, 627-5989. Practice @ 7:30am. Same course of fire as under Long Range Silhouette Match (200, 300, 385, and 500 meters) except that the shooter is allowed 2½ minutes to fire 5 rounds and firing is done from a bench. Silhouette animals have been replaced with 8"X10" steel plates (chickens were previously used) at all 4 distances. No "Armor Piercing" type ammo may be used. Target damaging loads will be determined by the Match Director and cannot be used. Practice starts at 8:00 A.M., match starts at 9:00 A.M. Both Scope and Iron Sight Classes. Award pins for Match Winner and Class Winner are available. Match fee \$6.00, free to first time shooters.

USPSA/IPSC (Combat Pistol) Match: Range #7. Sign up at 8:30 a.m., Match at 9:00. Match uses the rules and guidelines set up by USPSA. There will be 5 courses of fire that change every month. The courses of fire feature paper and steel targets. We use tables, barricades, boxes, and barrels for props. Match is open to any safe firearm that meets minimum caliber (9mm/.38) and using holsters that cover the trigger guard. A fun match, but **SAFETY** is constantly monitored and rigidly enforced. Visitors are welcome. Eye and ear protection is required. Match fee is \$13.00. Juniors fee of \$6.00. Contact Match Director Danny Moore at 910-8138, or Bob Scribner, 625-6764. 2nd SUNDAY:

Military Rifle - Cast Bullets Only: Range #3. Practice at 7:30am; Match starts @ 9:00am. Original receiver/barrels, with original as issued sights, stock and trigger modification are allowed. Cast bullets only, no military ball ammo or jacketed loads allowed. Match Fee is \$6.00. For additional information, contact Match Director John Wostal, 623-8199

WEDNESDAY before 3rd SUNDAY:

'O-F' Cowboy Rifle Silhouette: Range #3. Match Director Ernie Edmonston, 622-3328. Same as the Cowboy Rifle Silhouette match held on 3rd Sunday. Match Winner, Class Winner, and "In-a-Row" pins available (*).

3rd FRIDAY:

'O-F' .22 Benchrest Match: Sight-In Range. Match Director Jim Pruett, 622-0222. Spring/Summer Practice starts by 7:30am, match starts at 9:00am. Three classes: Sporting, up to 7½ pounds with scope no more than 6 power; 10.5 lbs. Class with scope of any power; Unlimited Weight Class with open scope power; and an Open Sights, any rifle class. Targets cost \$0.50. Bring target stand.

3rd SATURDAY:

SE New Mexico Mid-Range F-Class Competition: Range #4. Matches start at 9:00 A.M. March through October. Current NRA rules apply. Shooters will pull targets and score. Competitors may be asked to assist with Range Operations. Rifle rules 3.4, 3.4.1, 4.4, 4.5, 4.6, 5.6.1, 9.1 and 19.5.2 will apply. 30 round course plus sighters, 300, and 600 yards. Awards will be cash and awarded at the end of each match based on 3 or more competitors per class. Match Fee is \$8.00 per adult, \$5.00 per junior shooter (there will be a one-time fee of \$7.00 to pay for the NRA League Registration). Low Power Cast Bullet: Range #6. Same as 1st Sunday Low Power Match except that cast bullets must be used and cartridges must be center fire only. Match starts at 9:00 AM. Match Director Ernie Lewis @ 317-0114

Junior/Youth .22 LR Marksmanship: Range #6 March through October at 1:00pm. Any safe, serviceable, .22LR rifle may be used. Youth must show proof of completion of a State approved Hunter Safety Course to participate. Safety will be stringently monitored. Instruction in sight-picture, trigger control, and shooting form will be part of the instruction. Contact Match Director, C.W. Hamilton at 626-6234

Steel Challenge/SCSA Match: Range #7, Sign-up a half-hour before start at 9:00am {Standard time (9:30)}. Four stages of fire, rules & regs per SCSA. Recommend at least 125 rounds. May use any safe handgun, center-fire of 9mm/.38Spcl. or larger, and .22LR rimfire handguns & rifles are welcome too. This is a fun match but SAFETY is rigidly enforced. Eye & Ear Protection is required. Match fee is \$9.00, Juniors \$6.00; \$3.00 for a second division. Match Director, James Scordato, (702) 510-8145 [jvsnyes@hotmail.com]

3rd SUNDAY:

Long Range Pistol (LRP) Match: Range #3. Match Director; Ernie Edmonston, 622-3328. Practice 7:30 A.M., Match at 9:00. 40 rounds offhand, 10 @ 50m chickens, 10 @ 100m pigs, 10 @ 150m turkeys, and 10 @ 200m rams. NRA Rules apply. Competitors will be responsible for setting own targets. Awards presented as listed under "Low Power" Match above except pistol classifications are used. Match fee \$6.00.

Cowboy Rifle Silhouette: Starts in conjunction with LRP, course of fire same as LRP. Equipment: Pre-1895 Rifles (or replicas thereof) of at least 25 caliber, lever or slide-action with exposed hammer and tubular magazines. Single shot rifles of pre 1895 era allowed. Iron Sights only. Ammo: Rimmed case, round or flat point bullets. Classifications (both matches) are per N.R.A. rules. Match fee \$6.00. These matches are free to first time shooters. Check with Match Director for allow-ability of rifle selections.

WEDNESDAY before 4th Sunday:

'O-F' Cast Bullet Only Match: Range #3. Same as cast Bullet Only Match held on 4th Sunday except that there is no charge for this Match. Match Director; Ernie Lewis, 317-0114. Match Winner, Class Winner, and "In-a-Row" pins available (*).

4th SATURDAY:

Dennis Sullivan 22 Long Rifle Cartridge (100m) Silhouette Match: Range #6. Practice @ 7:30 a.m., match begins at 9:00. Course of fire same as "Low Power" Rifle Match (1st Saturday). Shooters will be responsible for resetting targets. Any .22 Rimfire firearm (except magnums) will be eligible to compete, separate classes for scope/iron sights. Classifications same as those listed under "Low Power" Match above. Awards also presented as in "Low Power" Match. Match fee \$6.00, free to first time shooters. Match Director: Ernie Edmonston 622-3328

4th SUNDAY:

Any Rifle, Any Sight, Cast Bullet Only Match: Range #3. Match Director Bill Kennedy. Practice 7:30 AM, Match starts at 9:00. Same as Cowboy 30-30 Match (3rd Sunday), except that any rifle, with any sight may be used providing a cast bullet is used. Separate classes for scope/iron sights. Match Fees \$6.00 adult, \$3.00 juniors. Free to first time shooters. Prizes awarded as in "Low Power" Match.

5th SATURDAY AND & OR 5th SUNDAY:

Special events or Miscellaneous "*Fun Matches*" most likely held on these days. Presently, the 5th Saturdays are Cowboy 200 meter silhouette matches with rifles using Pistol Cartridges (see Cowboy Rifle Silhouette, 3rd Sunday) on Range #3. Contact Ernie Edmonston at, 622-3328. 5th Sundays vary, but presently is 500 meter Silhouette fired from the Bench and IRON SIGHTS ONLY. Contact James Cravener 622-4097. These two matches are fee.
